Summer Camp Tuition Fees:

9:00 am-1:00 pm

\$270/week *\$40 nonrefundable registration fee due upon registering.

Pick-up and drop-off must be prompt.

All Summer Camp tuition fees must be paid in full to secure a spot. Tuition for summer camp are due on July 1st and August 1st. Prorated options are available for those who would like to attend the camp for fewer than 5 days.

*Withdrawals and refunds are nonrefundable one week prior to the beginning of camp. If you need to withdraw from a Summer camp, one week before the camp, a credit will be applied to your account for future dance classes or camps.

Registration:

Registration for Summer Camps will begin on February 1st, 2026, and continue through the last week of Summer Camp.

Our daily schedule:

9:00 am: Arrive and Welcome.

9:30-10:45 am: Craft of the day.

10:15-10:30 am: Wash hands and eat a Snack.

10:30-11:50 am: Rehearse and learn the dance that is associated with the theme of the week.

11:50-12:00 pm: Wash hands and get ready for lunch and a movie.

12:00-1:00 pm. Lunch and a movie. The movie aligns with the camp's theme. Pick up.

*Everyone should bring their own lunch.

You are welcome to bring a blanket and a pillow for movie time.

There will be a small show for parents on Friday, with pickup at 1:00 p.m.

Dress Code:

Campers should wear comfortable dance or athletic wear. Dance shoes are acceptable, but are not required.

Summer Intensives: (Studio B)

\$270/week (No registration fee)

Pick-up and drop-off must be prompt.
